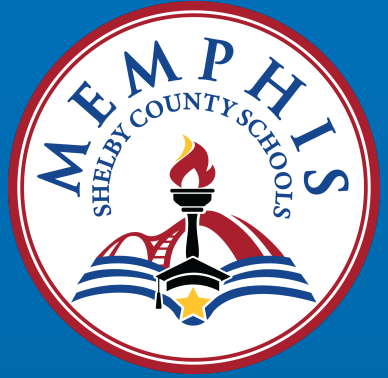


Towanna Murphy
